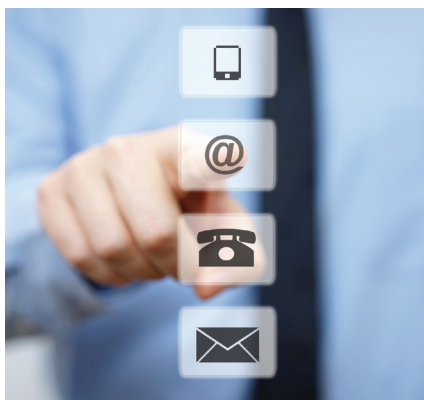

Protecting Patients, Practitioners and Staff During the COVID-19 Pandemic

In anticipating the need to support its members' safe and effective return to caring for patients following the COVID-19 shutdown, OCA created a **Return to Practice Playbook** with practical resources, tools and templates. This playbook aligns with and builds on the CCO Return to Practice guidance documents, Ontario Chief Medical Officer of Health and Ontario Ministry of Health directives. PROTECTION DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

CCO Policy on Considering Applications for Registration During the COVID-19 Pandemic

The College of Chiropractors of Ontario (CCO) adopted a temporary registration policy (Policy P-058) to accommodate applicants who were unable to write the May/June CCEB examinations and CCO Legislation and Ethics Examination during the COVID-19 pandemic.

This temporary policy addresses challenges resulting from the pandemic that prevented new graduates and other applicants from being able to complete the usual registration requirements.

CCO adopted this policy because it recognized:

- A compelling public interest in ensuring patients' access to chiropractic services.
- The value of enabling applicants to keep their competence current at the crucial period of time between completing their education and beginning independent practice.

This policy states that a panel of the Registration Committee may offer specific accommodations to the applicant, during the COVID-19 pandemic only, where an applicant meets all of the other registration requirements.

This accommodation includes appropriate mentorship and guidance from a CCO member during a new graduate's transition from completing their education to beginning their independent practice.

Please Note: CCO will further review this temporary policy by December 1, 2020. Timelines and provisional certification details are accurate as of publication time but could change in response to future COVID-19 developments.

Did you know? CCEB examination results take approximately four weeks to process. Upon successful completion of the CCEB examination and CCO Legislation and Ethics Examination, CCO will send candidates an application form to be completed for membership.

Step 2: For licensing, apply to CCO

Prospective CCO members must first:

- Graduate from an accredited chiropractic college (this requirement is non-exemptible)
- Successfully complete the Canadian Chiropractic Examining Board examinations
- Successfully complete CCO's Legislation and Ethics examination. For questions about registration: bit.ly/CCO-Exam

Did you know? CCPA protection is only available to chiropractors in Canada who are members of the CCA and their provincial chiropractic association.

Step 5: Apply to CCPA

To qualify, make sure to meet this checklist of requirements:

- A Doctor of Chiropractic Degree from an accredited chiropractic college, such as CMCC, UQTR or University of Western States
- Successful completion of the CCEB examination
- Licensure from your relevant provincial regulator
- Membership in good standing in the Canadian Chiropractic Association and your relevant provincial chiropractic association, such as the OCA

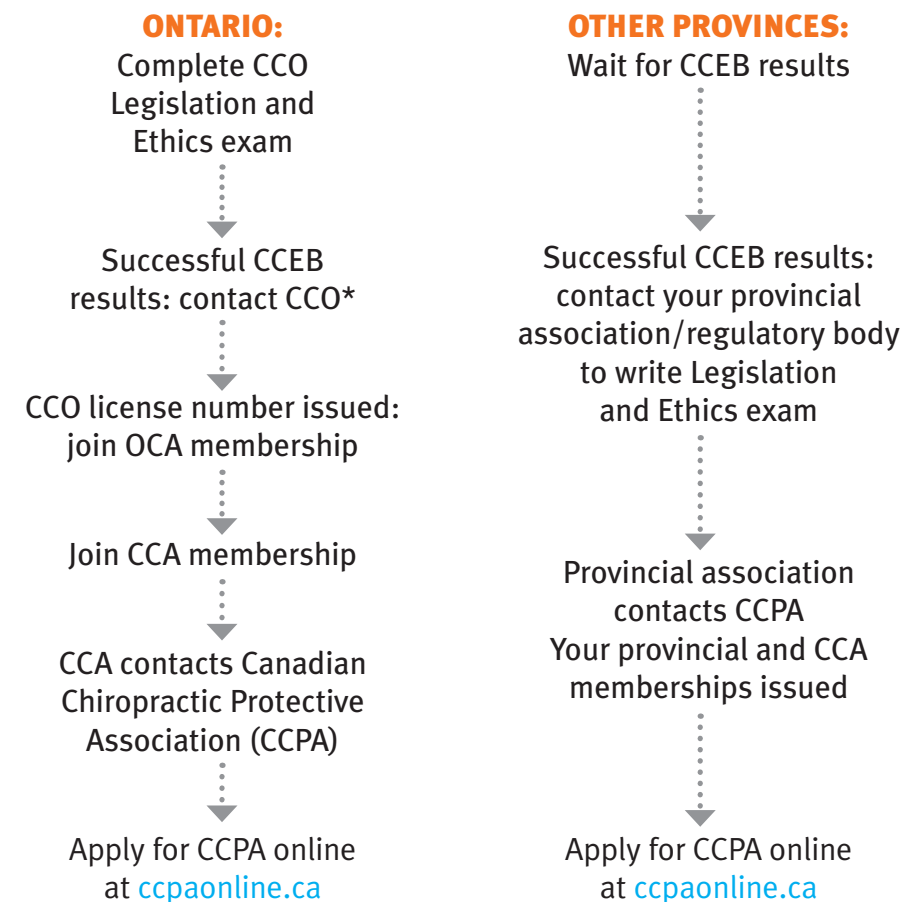

CCO CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION

The College of Chiropractors of Ontario (CCO) is the governing body established by the provincial government to regulate chiropractors for the public interest. Every chiropractor practicing in Ontario must be a registered member of the College.

CCO's Role

- To regulate the profession in the public interest in accordance with the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991, the Chiropractic Act, 1991, regulation and by-laws.
- To register qualified applicants as chiropractors in Ontario.
- To maintain a public register.
- To investigate and review complaints and reports.
- To conduct discipline hearings.
- To develop and implement a quality assurance program, which includes self, peer and practice assessment, continuing education and professional development.
- To develop and maintain standards of practice and professional ethics.

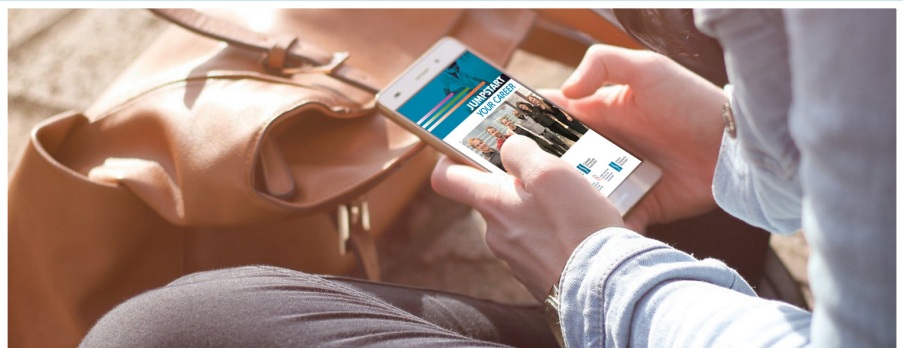
